

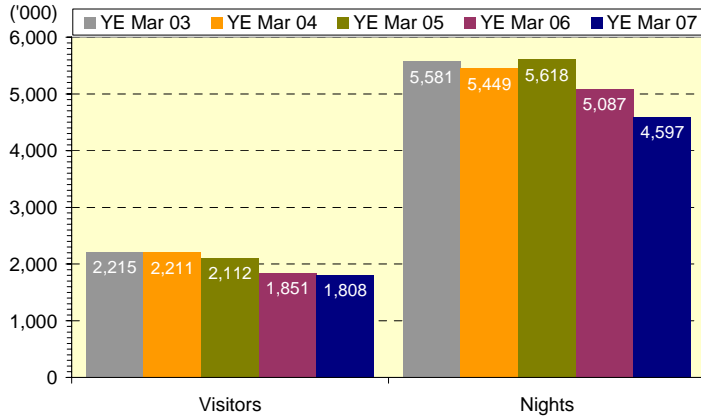

Domestic Overnight Travel

Note: The number of trips taken domestically by Australians increased by 5.1 percent on last year, but was down by 2.4 percent compared to four years ago.

Visitors and nights

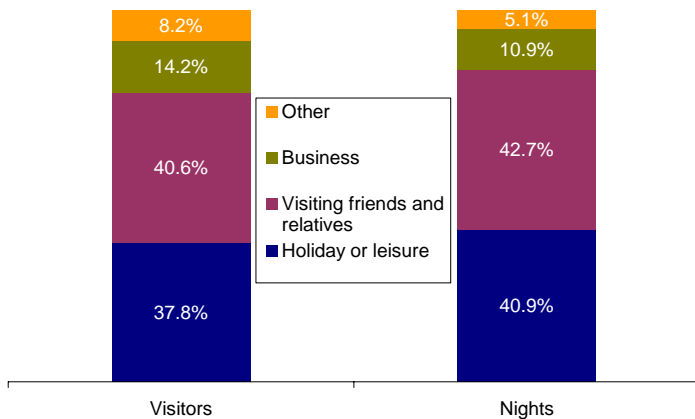


The region received over 1.8 million domestic overnight visitors - down by 2.3% on YE Mar 06. Visitors spent almost 4.6 million nights in the region - down by 9.6% on YE Mar 06.

Market share

The region received 10.3% of visitors to and 7.4% of nights in Regional NSW. Compared to YE Mar 06, the share of visitors was down by 0.8% points and share of nights was down by 1.2% points.

Purpose of visit



Visitors - 'Visiting friends and relatives' (40.6%) was the largest purpose for visitors to the region. 'Holiday or leisure' (37.8%) was the 2nd largest, followed by 'Business' (14.2%).

Nights - 'Visiting friends and relatives' (42.7%) was the largest purpose in terms of nights in the region. 'Holiday or leisure' (40.9%) was the 2nd largest, followed by 'Business' (10.9%).

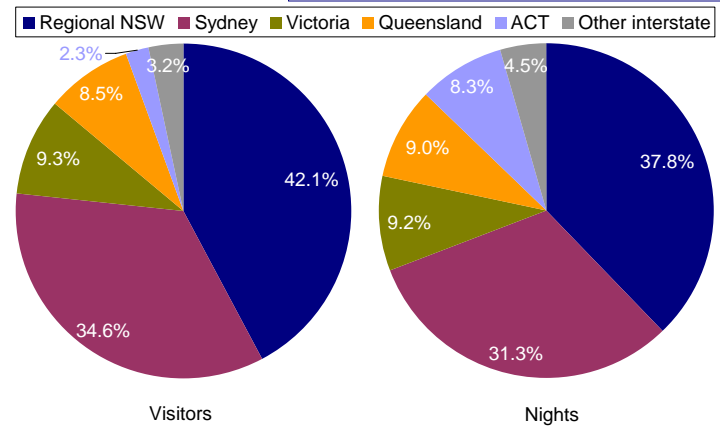
Accommodation

Almost 1/2 (49.1%) of nights in the region were spent in 'Friends or relatives property'. 'Standard hotel, motor inn, below 4 star' (22.5%) was the 2nd most popular, followed by 'Caravan park or commercial camping ground' (10.9%).

Activities

Over 2/5 (43.7%) of visitors to the region 'Visited friends and relatives'. 'Eat out at restaurants' (41.3%) was the 2nd most popular activity, followed by 'General sight seeing' (23.0%) and 'Pubs clubs discos etc' (21.2%).

Origin



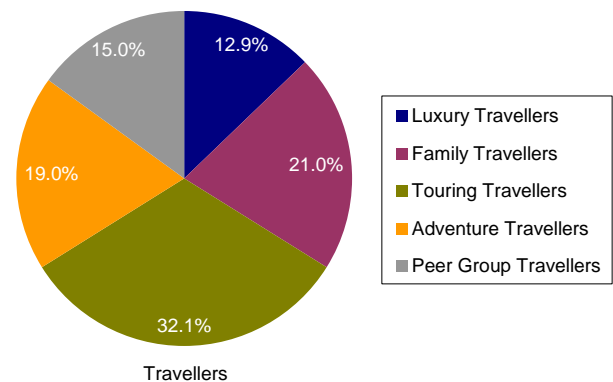
The region received over 3/4 (76.7%) of visitors and more than 2/3 (69.1%) of nights from intrastate (Regional NSW contributed more than Sydney for both visitors and nights).

Nearly 1/4 (23.3%) of visitors and over 3/10 (30.9%) of nights came from interstate (Victoria was the biggest interstate market for both visitors and nights).

Transport

Over 9/10 (90.4%) of visitors to the region travelled by 'Private or company car'. 'Air transport' (3.8%) was the 2nd most popular, followed by 'Bus or coach' (1.9%).

Australian travel segments ⁽¹⁾



Almost 1/3 (32.1%) of visitors to the region were 'Touring travellers'. 'Family travellers' (21.0%) was the 2nd largest travel segment, followed by 'Adventure travellers' (19.0%).

An estimated 5,900 (5.0%) of the region's workforce were employed in the tourism industry.

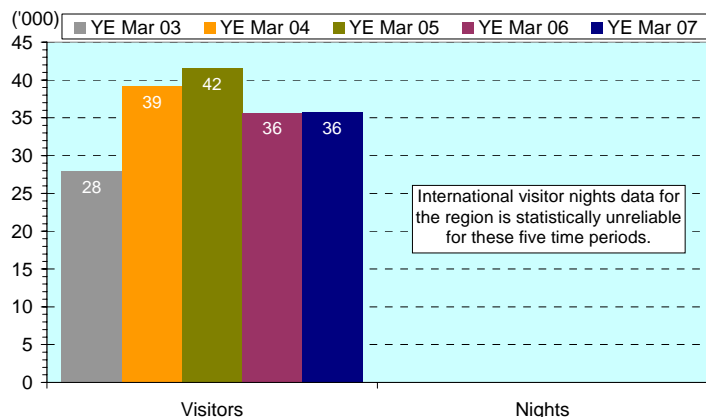

International Overnight Travel

Visitors and nights



The region received 35,700 international overnight visitors - up by 0.1% on YE Mar 06. International visitor nights data for the region is statistically unreliable for these five time periods.

Note: The number of overnight trips to Australia by international visitors increased by 2.7 percent on last year and by 16.5 percent compared to four years ago.

Market share

The region received 6.2% of visitors to and 5.4% of nights in Regional NSW. Compared to YE Mar 06, the share of visitors was down by 0.2% points and the share of nights was up by 0.1% point.

Purpose of visit

'Holiday/pleasure' (61.6%) was the largest purpose for visitors to the region. 'Visiting friends and relatives' (21.5%) was the 2nd largest, followed by 'Business' (11.7%).

'United Kingdom' (26.1%) was the region's largest source market of visitors, followed by 'New Zealand' (18.4%) and 'USA' (10.7%).

Accommodation

Over 2/5 (40.1%) of nights in the region were spent in 'Home of friend or relative'. 'Homestay' (17.5%) was the 2nd most popular, followed by 'Rented house / apartment / unit / flat' (12.8%).

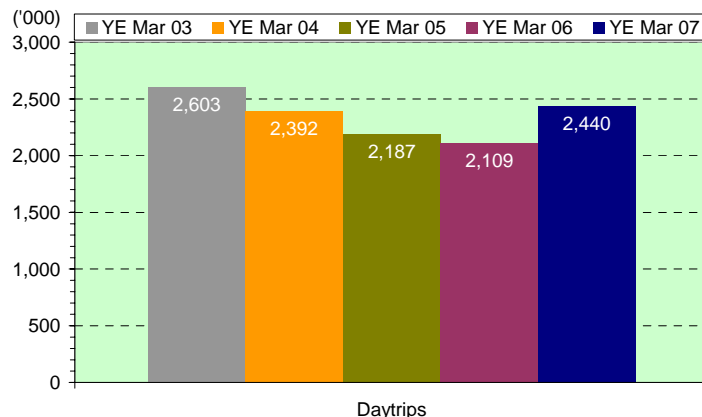
Expenditure (incl package expenditure) ⁽⁴⁾

Domestic Daytrip Travel

Trips



The region received over 2.4 million domestic daytrip visitors - up by 15.7% on YE Mar 06.

Note: Nationally, the number of daytrips trips taken domestically by Australians increased by 5.4 percent on last year, but was down by 2.8 percent compared to four years ago.

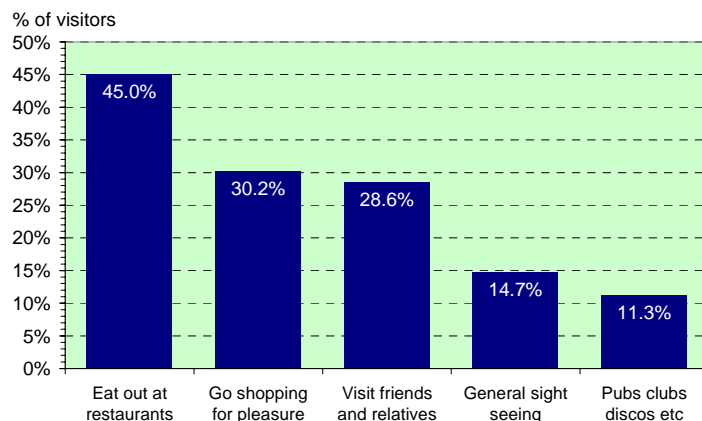
Market share

The region received 8.4% of daytrips to Regional NSW. Compared to YE Mar 06, the share was up by 0.9% points.

Purpose of visit

'Holiday or leisure' (49.1%) was the largest purpose for visitors to the region. 'Visiting friends and relatives' (22.1%) was the 2nd largest, followed by 'Health related' (12.0%).

Activities



Nearly 1/2 (45.0%) of visitors to the region 'Ate out at restaurants'. 'Go shopping' (30.2%) was the 2nd most popular activity, followed by 'Visit friends and relatives' (28.6%) and 'General sight seeing' (14.7%).

Age

Nearly 1/4 (23.8%) of visitors to the region were aged '45-54 years'. The 2nd largest age group was '35-44 years' (21.9%).

Expenditure ⁽⁵⁾

Domestic daytrip visitors spent, on average, \$137 per trip to the region.
